ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

College Level Entrance Examination — Session 2026-2027

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to the GNM and B.Sc. Nursing programmes for the academic session 2026-2027 through a College Level Entrance Examination. Interested candidates must apply online, pay the registration fee, and appear in the entrance test.

1. Courses Offered

- **G.N.M. (General Nursing & Midwifery)** — 3 years — 30 Seats
- **B.Sc. Nursing** — 4 years (08 Semesters) — 30 Seats

Reservation: 50% of seats in each course are reserved for Female candidates. This reservation is maintained in both the First Round and the Spot Round of allotment.

Note: Admit card release, date of entrance examination, result and counselling dates are tentative — exact dates will be published on the official website www.lbknc.com. Any change in schedule will be published on the official website www.lbknc.com. Candidates are advised to check the portal and registered contact channels regularly.

3. Eligibility Criteria

Age: Candidate must be between 17 and 35 years of age as on 31.12.2026 (i.e. born on or before 31.12.2009). For Persons with Disability (PWD), the upper age limit is relaxed by 5 years (maximum 40 years).

GNM: Passed 10+2 (any stream) with minimum 40% aggregate marks and minimum 40% in English.

B.Sc. Nursing: Passed 10+2 with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) — minimum 45% marks in PCB taken together for General/EWS (40% for SC/ST/OBC). English is compulsory; a minimum of 45% in English is prescribed as part of the institute admission policy. Eligibility shall otherwise be in conformity with the norms of the Indian Nursing Council / competent authority, as applicable.

- Candidates from State Open School / NIOS with Science and English are also eligible.
- Colour-blind candidates are eligible provided corrective lenses/spectacles are used.
- Candidate must be medically fit. Married candidates are also eligible.

4. Registration Fee & Payment

A registration fee of **Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only)** is payable.

Payment Instructions: Pay using the QR code shown on the portal, and then upload the payment screenshot together with the UTR / transaction reference on the portal.

IMPORTANT: The application will be marked as **SUBMITTED** only after the payment is verified by the Institution. Until verification, the status will remain **PENDING**. Pending applications are not considered valid submissions.

Refund: The registration fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE**. However, if the entrance examination or the admission process is cancelled by the institute, the fee paid will be refunded.

5. Entrance Examination Pattern

The entrance test consists of 44 questions for a total of 100 marks (40 Multiple-Choice Questions and 4 Short-Answer Questions). Duration: 2 hours. There is NO negative marking on Multiple-Choice Questions. Minimum qualifying marks: 50%.

Note: Short-answer questions appear only in Aptitude for Nursing and English (2 questions of 5 marks each). All other questions are Multiple-Choice. Syllabus is of 10+2 standard for the respective subjects.

6. Examination Day Instructions

- **Reporting Time:** Candidates must report at the examination venue by 10:30 AM. The examination gate will be closed at 10:30 AM. No late entry will be permitted thereafter.
- **Bring with you:** printed Admit Card, one valid original photo identity proof (Aadhaar / Voter ID / PAN / Driving License / Passport), and two passport-size photographs.
- **Allowed in the hall:** blue or black ball-point pen only.
- **NOT allowed:** mobile phone, smart-watch, calculator, books, paper, bag, electronic devices of any kind. Such items must be deposited outside the hall; the institute is not responsible for any loss.
- **Conduct:** any use of unfair means will lead to immediate disqualification.

- **Roll Number:** Candidates must locate their seat as per the roll number printed on the admit card. Verify your details on the answer sheet before starting.

7. Selection Process & Seat Allotment

Admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit obtained in the College Level Entrance Examination — higher marks rank higher in the merit list.

- Total seats: G.N.M. — 30 and B.Sc. Nursing — 30.
- Out of the total seats in each course, **50% seats (15) are reserved for Female candidates** and the remaining **50% seats (15) are open to all eligible candidates** on the basis of merit.
- **Male admission cap:** Across all rounds combined (First Round and any Spot Round), the total number of **male candidates admitted in each course shall not exceed 15 (50% of total seats)**. Once this cap is reached, no further male candidate shall be admitted — vacant seats shall be filled exclusively from among eligible female candidates by merit rank.
- Female candidates are eligible to be considered against **both the open seats and the female-reserved seats**. As a result, the total number of admitted female candidates may equal or exceed 50% of the sanctioned intake.
- Reservation / relaxation for SC / ST / OBC / EWS / PwD candidates is applicable only to the minimum qualifying marks required in the requisite educational qualification, as specified in the eligibility criteria above. Admission to seats shall be based on merit secured in the entrance examination. Any category-wise reservation of seats, if applicable, shall be implemented in accordance with the provisions notified by the competent authority.

First Round (Provisional Seat Allotment based on Merit)

- Provisional Seat Allotment Letters shall be issued separately for B.Sc. Nursing and GNM (30 seats each) strictly on the basis of merit secured in the Entrance Examination.
- Walking the merit list from rank 1, candidates are admitted in order of merit, subject to: (a) the **male cap of 15** per course, and (b) the **female-reserved quota of 15** seats that can be filled only by eligible female candidates.
- Candidates who receive a Provisional Seat Allotment Letter must report for counselling on the date and time specified therein and complete all admission formalities, including payment of college fees.
- **Important:** If an allotted candidate fails to report for counselling within the stipulated period or does not complete the admission process, the provisional allotment shall stand **CANCELLED** automatically.
- In such cases, the specific reason for cancellation shall be displayed against the candidate's Name and Application No. / Roll No. on the **College Website and the Candidate Portal**.
- Upon cancellation of allotment, access to candidate portal services (including the Allotment Letter and related admission facilities) may be restricted for the concerned admission round.

Spot Round (Filling of Vacant Seats after First Round)

- A Spot Round shall be conducted only for seats remaining vacant after completion of the First Round.
- All candidates who were not allotted a seat in the First Round (Waitlisted) shall be considered **strictly according to their original course-wise merit rank**.
- **The male cap of 15 per course continues to apply across all Spot Rounds.** If the male cap has already been reached, no further male candidates shall be promoted from the waitlist; all remaining vacancies shall be offered to the next eligible female candidates by merit.
- **Cancelled candidates from any prior round are NOT eligible for the Spot Round.**
- Eligible candidates must report to the Institute on the notified Spot Round date by 11:00 AM with all original documents and applicable college fees. Admission against vacant seats shall be granted from 2:00 PM onwards strictly in order of merit, subject to the above cap.
- If vacant seats remain unfilled after a Spot Round, the Institute may conduct one or more **additional Spot Rounds**, subject to availability of seats and administrative feasibility. The eligibility, merit order, female reservation, and male-cap rules shall continue to apply unless otherwise notified.

- The Institute reserves the right to modify the schedule, conduct additional rounds of counselling, or discontinue further rounds if all seats are filled. The decision of the Institute regarding seat allotment and admission shall be final and binding.

Confirmation of Admission

- After successful counselling, college fees payment and document verification, the institute will mark the candidate's status as **CONFIRMED** in the system. An Admission Confirmation Letter will be made available on the candidate portal once published by the institute.

Tie-breaking (in order, as per the institute's admission policy): (1) candidate with higher age; (2) higher marks in English from this entrance exam; (3) female candidate.

Final admission is subject to document verification, medical fitness, fulfilment of eligibility criteria, and payment of college fees.

8. Communication & Candidate Portal

IMPORTANT — Stay informed: All updates regarding Admit Card release, Result publication, Counselling Schedule, Seat Allotment, and Admission Confirmation will be sent to the candidate's **registered Email ID**. Candidates are advised to keep email active until the admission process is fully completed and to add the institute's sender ID to their safe list.

- **Candidate Login Portal:** Visit "www.lbknc.com/admissions" and log in with your registered Mobile + Email + Date of Birth.
- From the portal you can: print your Application, download Admit Card, view Result and Rank, download Allotment Letter, and download the Admission Confirmation Letter (once published).
- If your registered mobile number or email needs to be changed, contact the institute office in writing along with a valid ID proof BEFORE the admit card is released. Changes after admit card issuance may not be possible.

9. How to Apply

- Visit the institute's official online application portal: **www.lbknc.com/admissions**
- Read the eligibility criteria and instructions carefully and click on "Apply Now".
- Fill in all required details correctly. The form can be submitted only once — review all fields before final submission.
- Upload a recent passport-size photograph (white background, max 100 KB) and signature (max 50 KB) in JPG/PNG.
- Pay the registration fee of Rs. 500/- — scan the QR, then upload the payment screenshot with the UTR / transaction reference.
- Submit the form, note your Application Number, and wait for payment verification. The status will change from PENDING to SUBMITTED only after the payment has been verified.
- Log in to the Candidate Portal using your Mobile + Email + DOB to track your status, download Admit Card, Result and Allotment Letter.

10. Details / Documents Required to Fill the Online Application Form

- Recent passport-size photograph (white background) and signature image.
- Aadhaar number.
- 10th and 12th details — board, year of passing, roll number and percentage.
- Valid mobile number, email ID and complete address.
- UTR / transaction reference and payment screenshot (for offline payment).

11. Documents Required at Document Verification / Admission

- Class 10th admit card, marksheet and passing certificate.
- Class 12th admit card, marksheet and passing certificate.

- Transfer Certificate (TC)/College Leaving Certificate (CLC)/ Character Certificate from Class 12th or last attended institution.
- Migration Certificate from Board or University (where applicable).
- Entrance exam admit card and score / rank card.
- Caste / Category certificate (for SC / ST / OBC / EWS, if applicable).
- PwD certificate (if applicable).
- PAN Card and Aadhaar Card.
- 6 passport-size colour photographs.
- Seat Allotment Letter (printed from the candidate portal).
- College admission form (duly filled).
- College Fee payment details / receipt.

Note: Candidates must bring all original documents mentioned above along with two sets of self-attested photocopies. Verification will be conducted at the institute on the counselling date.
